




# New River Valley Trail Counter Program

Count Begin: 30-May-15



Did you know?



- Over 500 people used this segment of trail in three weeks
- Each day, about 35 people use this segment of the trail
- About 40% of folks use this segment of trail on the weekend
- Trail use is relatively consistent through the week
- Saturday is the most popular day, about 22% of use
- About 60% of users prefer afternoons along this trail segment
- During this observation period, folks typically started using this portion of the trail around 8:00 am
- During this observation period, folks were typically finished using this portion of the trail around 7:00 pm
