




New River Valley Trail Counter Program


Counter Location



Did you know?

- Over 230 people use this segment of trail each week
- Each day, over 30 people use this segment of the trail
- About 38% of folks use this segment of trail on the weekend
- Tuesday is the least popular day, slightly less than 10% of use
- Sunday is the most popular day, more than 20% of use
- Users prefer afternoons during weekdays
- Weekends trail usage is equal in the morning and afternoon
- During this observation period, multiple folks started using this portion of the trail around 6:30 am
- During this observation period, most folks were finished using this portion of the trail around 7:45 pm
