

Counter Location: Huckleberry Trail - Blacksburg


Location Description: Approximately 0.15 miles north of Southgate Drive and 0.4 miles south of Miller Avenue


Counter Location



Did you know?

- Nearly 11,000 people used this segment of trail in two weeks
- Each day, about 515 people use this segment of the trail
- If you observed this segment of trail, during the peak hour, a person would pass by every 30 seconds
- About 28% of folks use this segment of trail on the weekend
- Friday is the least popular day, slightly more than 9% of use
- Monday is the most popular day, nearly 17% of use
- Users prefer afternoons along this trail segment
- During this observation period, multiple folks started using this portion of the trail around 5:00 am
- During this observation period, most folks were finished using this portion of the trail around 10:00 pm
