

## PLANTING FOR CHILDREN IN PULASKI

Plants are an excellent opportunity to add beauty, function, nature, color, food, and fascination to any playspace. To create a low-maintenance and effective landscape that will flourish in our climate of Southwest Virginia, it is recommended that native and climate appropriate plants are utilized where possible. Native plants work well with the local climate, soils and wildlife and provide little input or maintenance after establishment. There are many easy to grow natives that will thrive in the Town of Pulaski. Invasive species are detrimental to the local ecosystem and should be avoided.
